



2018-2019 Tuition & Fee Schedule

Our 2017-2018 tuition program continues as a step forward into 2018-2019 in order to provide an affordable, high quality, and authentically Catholic education for all families regardless of size. Families will be charged tuition **only** for the two oldest children enrolled at Our Lady of the Rosary Catholic School.** However, all non-paying students will be charged for testing (\$100.00 if applicable), registration fee (\$350.00), book fee (\$450.00), Arrowsmith book fee (\$350.00), T-shirt fee (\$15.00), and a capital improvement fee (\$100.00). **Families with an Arrowsmith Student, please refer to the Arrowsmith Tuition and Fee Schedule. An Arrowsmith student is not considered for free OLR or Arrowsmith tuition.**

Financial Aid

Financial aid is available to **OLR Parishioners** with students in Grades K4-9. If you are interested in applying for financial aid, please visit the Tuition Aid Data Service FACTS website at factsmgt.com/aid as soon as possible, as an application and application fee for tuition assistance must be received by April 15th in order to allow time to review and inform families of final decisions. In addition, we encourage non-parishioners to contact their Pastor in order to seek financial assistance for their child's education. Furthermore, you will need to fill out the FACTS Financial Aid application in order to receive Scholarship money from the Diocesan St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Scholarship, Exceptional SC, and Choral Scholarship. Additional Information

Tuition and all fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Tuition is due and payable according to your FACTS management tuition agreement. There will be a \$35 late fee charged if your FACTS agreement payment date is not honored.
